CITY OF IRONWOOD TRASH AND RECYCLING CHANGES EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 2014

Effective May 1, 2014 the City of Ironwood has contracted with Eagle Waste & Recycling, Inc. (Eagle Waste) based out of Ashland and Eagle River, WI to provide weekly trash and weekly recycling drop off site collection for all eligible City of Ironwood residents. The enhanced service will include the addition of solid waste containers that will be provided for every household. These containers are a much easier and neater way for you to dispose of your trash. The containers will be owned by Eagle Waste and provided at no charge to each eligible household prior to your first pickup by Eagle Waste.

Each eligible household will receive one 64-gallon cart for their trash. The 64-gallon cart is on wheels and will be very easy to roll out on your collection day. If a larger 96-gallon cart is needed, one will be provided at an additional charge of \$3.00 per month. **If needed, please contact Eagle Waste at 715.477.0077.**

Your cart will be picked up by a fully automated system and will need to be specifically located at the curb (or designated spot in the alley). The cart is picked-up with an arm that extends out from the truck. Therefore, the driver does not have to get out of the truck to pick-up your trash. A video showing this collection procedure and explaining the cart placement can be found on our web site at www.eaglewasteandrecycling.com in the Florence and Crandon starburst. Please make sure that the cart is at least three feet from telephone poles, vehicles and other obstacles to allow the automated arm to pick it up. **All trash will need to be contained in the cart unless properly stickered.**

Ironwood will be going to **SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING**, which means that many new items are available for you to recycle. You will be able to put all recyclables at any of the four (4) designated recycling stations around town. **Remember, NO PLASTIC BAGS. Recyclables should be placed loosely into the 8 yard containers.**

Eagle Waste will be picking-up three (3) days per week: Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday instead of the current four (4) days. **Eagle Waste will be providing service on ALL HOLIDAYS with the exception of Christmas.** If Christmas falls on or before your collection day, you will be picked-up one day later. For example, in 2014, Christmas falls on Thursday. Wednesday customers will not be affected. Thursday customers will be picked-up on Friday and Friday customers will be picked-up on Saturday.

The City of Ironwood and Eagle Waste & Recycling, Inc. both look forward to the enhanced trash and recycling services that will start on May 1, 2014. We thank you for your patience and support as this transition takes place.
